INTEGRATION OF THE COGNITION RESULTS IN LAW SCIENCE

Abstract. Article is devoted to search of a way to integration of the cognition results in law science. The purpose of integration consists in unambiguous understanding of legal reality and its evolution. The research has cross-disciplinary character: particular linguistic paradoxes that have appeared within the framework of the state and law theory are considered by the author not only from a legal, but also from a linguistic, psychological, and even theological point of view.
