## **STATISTICS OF SOCIAL AND LABOR CONFLICTS IN SVERDLOVSK REGION**

**Abstract:** This article analyzes statistics of social and labor conflicts that occurred in the Sverdlovsk region in the period from 2013 to 2016. Statistical relative indicators are indicated that measure the quantitative and qualitative characteristics of conflicts. Further, the statistics of social and labor conflicts are compared according to the Center for Analysis and Monitoring "Labor Conflicts" of Federation of Independent Russian Trade Unions in the St. Petersburg Trade Unions' Humanitarian University and according to the Federal State Statistics Service. The authors analyze and evaluate the dynamics of social and labor conflicts in the Sverdlovsk region in the period from 2013 to 2016. In addition, the article analyzes the causes of social and labor conflicts. The statistical dependence is revealed of the social and labor conflicts number from the macroeconomic and political situation in the country. The conclusion contains specialists' forecasts on the number of social and labor conflicts in the Sverdlovsk region in 2017.
