

THE CONTRACTUAL PARENTAL LABOR AND ITS PREVALENCE IN THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

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Abstract. The article reveals with the understanding of one of the varieties of the parental labor - the contractual parental labor. The authors describe the forms of its realization, the specificity of the subject and the object of the labor. The authors suggest a number of the classification of the contractual parental labor – on its potential objects, their age, the subjects of labor, the form of implementation. Based on the official statistics of the Russian Federation analyzed the dynamics of the spread of individual forms of contractual parental labor over the past 10 years. It is describes the structure of forms of realization for children of certain age categories. Based on the calculation of the median values of the indicators analyzed the distribution and quality of the implementation of this kind of labor in the constituent entities of the Russian Federation.

The authors attempt to systematize existing in Russia incentives of different forms of the contractual parental labor. It is concluded that stimulation of the parent contract labor directly indicates that the activities in the education and development of children labor is recognized at the state level. The state, establishing certain measures to support the implementation of contractual forms of parental work, can directly affect this process, acting as a sort of «customer» of its results.
