

ASSESSMENT OF THE LABOUR RESOURCES IN THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN IN THE CONDITIONS OF INNOVATIVE DEVELOPMENT OF ECONOMY

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Abstract. The article examines the factors affecting the process of reproduction of labor resources of Kazakhstan. To identify the specifics of workforce development to create the conditions of their reproduction in Kazakhstan assessed regions of the country on the basis of the rating of the number obtained by the results of the research as an integrated component of the assessment of the conditions of formation, distribution and use of human resources in view of their trends over the past five years. Based on the analysis in the identified three typological groups («A», «B», «C»), been given their substantial socio-economic characteristics. The authors concluded that the development of measures of state regulation of the active labor policy should be based on the results of the study in a differentiated and targeted.
