

THE CRITICALITY LABOUR MARKET OF THE SVERDLOVSK REGION AND PERVOURALSK

Abstract. One of the most important macroeconomic indicators of the country and the region is the state of the labor market, which is attention, as the situation on the labor market is a key factor in the economy. Information about the labor market is important tool when development economic and social policy of the state. Economic instability and global political developments have a direct impact on the labor market, causing excessive employment in one sector of the economy and the shortage of skilled labor in another.
